REEF VIEW HOTEL

This high-rise hotel is located opposite the main resort beach, Catseye Beach. Every room offers stunning views, either out over the sparkling Coral Sea or the island's lush tropical gardens. We are holding a large number of rooms; all have a balcony and <u>include breakfast for one or two persons</u>:

- Single rooms (for one person) with a king bed or two queen beds.
- Double rooms (for two persons) with one king bed or two queen beds.
- Twin rooms (for two persons) with two queen size beds.
- Family rooms (up to six persons) with two bedrooms, one king bed and two single beds.
- Rollaway beds are available at an additional cost of \$60 per bed per night.

Maximum number of guests per room is four guests. More than two adults are at an additional cost of \$60 per adult per night.

PALM BUNGALOWS

There are twenty ground floor garden bure bungalows set in the grounds of the island resort. They can be booked as single occupancy (one person) or double occupancy (two persons). Buffet breakfast is included at the Reef View Hotel.

WHITSUNDAY APARTMENTS

We have several one-bedroom apartments, which contain a living room and a separate bedroom with a king bed and a single divan. The living room has two single divans, so can be used for up to five persons. They all have a balcony but do not include breakfast as the apartments contain a kitchen with microwave over, stove & grill, oven, refrigerator, crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils, toaster, kettle. The island has an IGA supermarket.

THE SUNDAYS

The Sundays, Hamilton Island's new boutique hotel. Nestled at the northern end of palm fringed Catseye Beach, The Sundays offers beautiful rooms overlooking the Coral Sea. We have a limited number of one-bedroom suites, available with a King bed or two single beds configuration. The Sundays' guests enjoy exclusive access to the hotel's private swimming pool and cabanas as well as its waters-edge restaurant and bar with spectacular views over the aquatic playground that is Catseye Bay.

PERSONAL EXPENSES

Dry Cleaning/laundry, mini bar items, personal bar beverages, room service and restaurant meals charged to your room are at your own expense. This includes any extra breakfast charged to your room. Only event organised functions and conference program meals and beverages are taken care of.
